- Housekeepers will be asked to occasionally work in the laundry.

## **POSITION QUALIFICATIONS**

- Knowledge of or willingness to learn how to operate all Housekeeping equipment related to the job.
- Must be able to work independently and be a self-starter.
- Must be able to bend, lift, carry, push, and pull up to 50 lbs. using proper body mechanics.
- Must be able to lift overhead with 10 lbs.
- Must be able to stand on feet for long periods.
- Required to meet the training and safety requirements for the department.
- Requires the ability to be flexible in work routines, as unscheduled tasks will be requested routinely
- Demonstrate the ability to work around sick and dying people of all ages.

- Must be respectful of patient rights and privacy.
- Must be willing to work as a team with all coworkers.
- Must be willing to take direction from management and supervisors.
- Must follow all policies and procedures for the Home as well as the department.
- Must be willing to cooperate with other departments.
- Must be willing and able to follow a daily work schedule and be flexible in the work routine as needed.
- Must be willing to bring concerns, issues, or questions to immediate supervisor.
